Pastor Alvin Leon McNabb, age 77, passed away Sunday, June 5, 2016. A funeral service will be held Wednesday, June 8, 2016 at 11:00 AM at Grace Baptist Church of Eatonton. The family will receive friends from 10:00 AM until Service time. Burial will follow at 1:00 PM at the Georgia Veteran Memorial Cemetery in Milledgeville, Ga.
