Mr. James Glenn Quesenberry, age 85, of Eatonton passed away September 1, 2015. A Celebration of Life will be held, 2 PM Friday, September 11, in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home, Eatonton. The family will receive friends at Williams Funeral Home, Eatonton from 1 PM until the service hour.

Mr. Glenn, with two N's, was a native of Garfield Heights, OH. He was the son of the late James Daniel Quesenberry and the late Fannie Mae Gibson Quesenberry.
