“ Sometimes it takes someone's passing to realize what an impact a person has on your life. Although Julian & I have not seen one another in over 30 years, this news has impacted me deeply as I realized what he did for me. You see, my parents divorce had me living with my Mom at Lake Sinclair. As if dealing with my family being split apart wasn't hard enough, I suddenly was the 13 year old new kid on the block in Forest Lake Village and in 8th Grade at Putman County Middle School. As a goofy young teenager dealing with these issues I had a hard time fitting in, as this was unfamiliar territory. It was not going well for me and I was regretting the decision to come live there with my Mom. As fate would have it my new Best Friend was right across the street from me. Julian and I hit it off right from the start. His family accepted me just like I was part of the family. I'm not sure how I acquired this nickname, but somehow I became known to him as "Tom Bomb". I suppose he thought I looked like a Wrestler or something. Every afternoon after school and almost every weekend we were up to something. When we weren't raiding his Dads stash of Oreos, we were playing basketball, playing against his grandmothers wall at tennis, playing video games, riding bikes, or just doing the goofy things that teenagers do. As far as I'm concerned Julian was the best water skier on the planet during my time at the Lake. For competition prep Julian would let me drive his Dads boat and pull him all over the Lake after School. I'm not sure if his Dad was aware of this or not. Looking back on it I'm fairly certain he didn't. I'm not sure why they put so much trust in me. This was before GPS's so my chances of getting lost on the Lake were pretty high. They are lucky their boat didn't end up at the bottom of the lake somewhere. I cannot describe how empowering it was for me to be driving the boat at precision speed while watching Julian shred the water. A few fisherman fell victim to my lack of boating knowledge, but I believe their feelings were the only thing that got hurt. Even though Julian was a year older than me and in High School, it gave me some serious bragging rights at School the next day that I got to assist him in testing his skills on the Lake. He was always so encouraging and uplifting to me. He didn't judge me, question me on anything

*about my past. He stuck up for me when no one else did. He just wanted to be my friend. My time at the Lake only lasted about a year before I went back to live with my Dad. It was a hard decision because Julian and I had become such great friends. We did get to visit together once or twice after that. But as Life happens sometimes our paths went in different directions and we lost touch. Now that I am older I realize that God puts certain people in our lives to help us through difficult periods in our lives. Julian may not have known this but his friendship was one of the biggest blessings in my Life. He came into my life when what I needed more than anything was a friend. But he was not just a friend, he was my Best Friend, at a time when I needed it the most. Julian made a huge difference in my life and paved a path for me as an example of how to be genuine and kind to others. 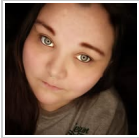
