Mrs. Lanelle Nation Frost, age 88, passed away Saturday, May 2, 2015. Funeral services will be conducted at 10 o'clock, Saturday Morning, May 9, 2015 at The First Baptist Church of Eatonton. Interment will follow at 2:30 PM in the Arlington Memorial Park in Atlanta. The family will receive friends at Williams Funeral Home of Eatonton, Friday Evening from 4 until 6.

Mrs. Frost was a native of Cartersville, Georgia. She was the daughter of the late Roy Nation and the late Dolly Hill Nation.
