Phillip David McMurry, 72, of Eatonton, Ga., passed away at his home on December 12, 2025.

Phillip was born in Shelby, N.C., on August 14, 1953, to the late Sedahlia Lydia Willis McMurry and Paul Edward McMurry. He was a member of Palm Tree Church in Lawndale, N.C.
